

Air Resources Board (ARB)

Because ARB recognizes that batteries produce minimal or no pollutant emission, ARB specifically set forth in title 13, California Code of Regulations section 2485(c)(3)(C) a provision that exempts battery-powered auxiliary power systems from the requirement to obtain advanced Executive Officer approval. Despite this, ARB has decided, as a matter of policy, to issue approval letters for exempt devices if such approval is requested by a manufacturer. Therefore, by this decision, ARB hereby approves the Sleeping Well as meeting the criteria contained in title 13, California Code of Regulations section 2485(c)(3)(C), thereby allowing the Sleeping Well to be installed and operated on any heavy-duty diesel-fueled vehicle with a gross weight rating over 10,000 pounds to comply with requirements set forth in title 13, California Code of Regulations section 2485.

ARB reserves the right to modify or revoke this approval at any time if such action is deemed necessary.
